

Barbara - just finished a very successful plains game hunt in Namibia with Wesfalen Safaris, PH John van der Westhuizen This operation has all the personalized treatment one would expect from a ranch hunt and all the amenities normally associated with a large "lodge" operation PH is a highly personable hunter who goes to great lengths to meet the clients interest in specific trophies.(drove me 400 km to find a decent warthog) Best plains game stalking I have seen in Africa in a dozen safaris. Took two 12" warthog, a 39' male Gemsbok and a great Mountain Zebra. PH has access to 300,000 acres and ONLY hunts free range animals and adheres to all "fair chase" standards.Wesfalen only takes one client(or one party) at a time and operates with the old fashioned integrity hard to find in this day and age. With daily rates at 300 dollars(2x1), this is a first class operation that is highly affordable.
